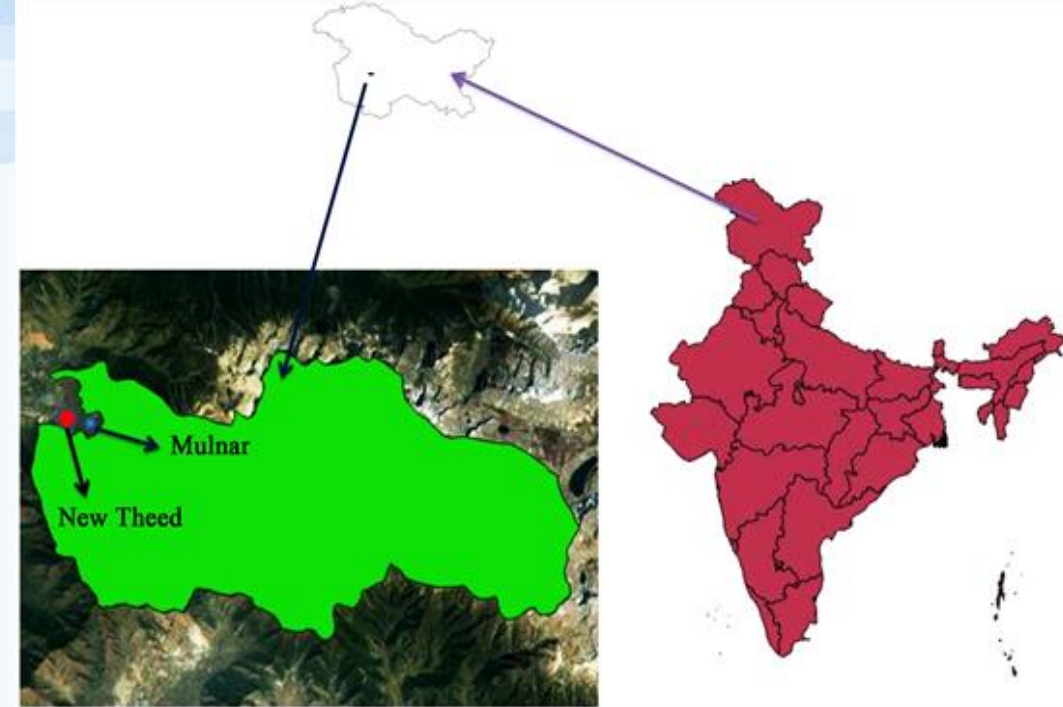


National Parks In Jammu and Kashmir.

Dachigam National Park

- It means ten villages.
- Declared a national park in 1981.
- Animals can be found here like “the Leopard, the musk deer, the Himalayan black bear, the jackal and many other unique animals like the hill fox”.
- It is home to the state animal (The hangul or the Kashmir stag).



Kishtwar National Park

- Declared a National park in the year 1981.
- Famous for being the place where the hangul migrates from the dachigam national park.



Salim Ali National park

- It is declared as a national park 1992.
- It is located in Srinagar.
- It's name is in honor of the famous India ornithologist, Salim Ali(1986).
- This is home to the endangered species of Kashmiri stag.
- Other animals Himalayan serow, Himalayan black bear.



Kazinag national park (Baramula)

- It is established in 1992.
- It is home to about 17 different species of butterflies that are unique and endangered.
- It is also home to Himalayan musk deer, Himalayan brown and black bears and snow leopards, Himalayan marmot.
